Swan Valley Community Foundation Academic Scholarship Application

The Swan Valley Community Foundation (SVCF) is pleased to announce they will be awarding up to two \$1500 (USD) scholarships to qualified 2025 graduating High School Seniors who live in the Condon area. The purpose of the scholarship is to help offset costs in pursuing post-secondary academic goals by providing financial support in the form of a scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The student must be currently enrolled in the Missoula, Flathead, or Lake County school system as attending either a public school in that county, Charter school, or homeschool, and will be graduating in the spring of 2025.
2. The student is a full-time (primary) resident of the Condon area. For purposes of the scholarship, boundary considerations residences between Summit Lake (off Highway 83), and Swan Lake.
3. The student has been accepted into a post-secondary formal training program, such as: an accredited University, Community College, or Trade-School, pursuing a course of study.
4. The student must submit the scholarship application answering all questions.
5. The student must include a High School transcript with the application.
6. From the application pool, potential recipients will be selected for an in-person interview with the SVCF Scholarship Panel.
7. Scholarship winners will be selected based on the written application, and performance during the interview. Interview tips and training can be provided.
8. If selected as the scholarship recipient, the student must provide a valid Social Security number, and photo for publication.
