2026 Swan Valley Community Foundation Community Service Awards

The annual Community Service Awards recognizes and thanks Swan Valley individuals that tirelessly work as an unpaid volunteer. These individuals freely dedicate personal time and resources benefiting Swan Valley organizations or projects, often with little or no public recognition. Their efforts help improve our community and enhance quality of life in the Swan Valley. Up to three individuals may receive this award each year at the Annual Community Celebration in June.

Any Swan Valley community organization, association, club, church, or ad-hoc group in good standing may nominate an individual for the Community Service Award. Each organization can nominate only one person. A director or officer of the nominating organization must submit and sign the nomination form. The individual who is nominated can, but does not have to, be a member of the nominating organization. Individuals may be nominated by more than one organization.

To meet the minimum criteria to qualify for this reward, the nominee:

- Is a resident of the Swan Valley (Summit to Soup Creek),
- Has not previously received this award,
- Has at least five years of unpaid volunteer service of 96 hours or more per year,
- Has served with one organization or project or multiple groups/projects.

The SVCF Awards Committee will review and score the nominees using the following scale.

Years of service	1 point per year
Projects	1 point per project
Orgs/Groups	1 point per group served
Nominations	5 points per each nomination received

The award will be kept secret until announced and presented as a surprise at the Annual Community Celebration. The Awards Committee will confidentially notify the director or officer submitting the successful nomination and ask that they bring the nominee to the Community Celebration on June 30th at the Hungry Bear Grill. The award is commemorated with a certificate and \$100 gift.

Unsuccessful applicants may be nominated again the following year. There is no limit on how many times a person can be sponsored. Please use the nomination form and email to: awards@swanvalleyfoundation.org Nominations must be received by June 19th, 2026
